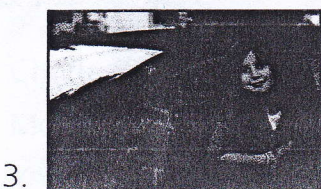
anybody / somebody

There isn't anybody in the kitchen, but there is somebody in the living room.



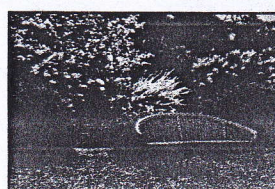
anything / something
