The Giant Panda

The Giant Panda is a bear. It has a black and white coat. It is usually 4-6 ft tall. Males are bigger than females. They weigh 330 lbs. Females usually have one or two cubs every two years. The cubs weigh only 3.5 - 7 oz and they're 6 - 6.8 in long.

Giant Pandas eat a lot of bamboo. They cut and eat the bamboo with their teeth. They have very strong teeth. Sometimes they also eat honey, eggs, fish, bananas and oranges.

There are Giant Pandas both in zoos and in the wild, but scientists say that the Giant Panda is one of the most endangered species. There are about 2,000 in the wild. China has 239 Giant Pandas in zoos and there are 27 in zoos in other countries.
